# THE RYAN'S WE It sure has been an eventful twenty years! From one little boy raising his hand in FOUNDATION



#### 1999

After learning from his Grade one teacher. Ms. Prest, that many people in the world do not have access to **clean water**, six-year-old Ryan fundraised enough money to complete his first well at Angolo Primary School in Uganda.

#### 2001

This year marked the release of the **50-minute** documentary, "Ryan's Well," directed by Lalita Krishna, which depicts the beginnings of Ryan's philanthropic journey, and his visit to his first well in Uganda.



#### 2002

Ryan was invited to lay a wreath at the Ottawa Cenotaph with Prince Charles and World War II veteran, the late Colonel Ernest Cöté.



#### 2003

It's an honour to be invited to speak on **Oprah** even once, but Ryan was invited TWICE - once in 2001, and again in 2003! Oprah told Ryan that he is "really living proof that one person, and it really doesn't matter how old you are, can really make a difference."



#### 2004

In Orlando, Florida, Ryan was a keynote speaker at Keller Williams Realty's family reunion, which sparked friendships and partnerships that greatly help the Ryan's Well Foundation to this day.





At just 15 years old, Ryan was one of only two youth delegates to accompany Her Excellency, Governor General, Michaëlle Jean, on a twenty-three day state visit to five African countries - Algeria, Mali, Ghana, South Africa, and Morocco.

#### 2000

 Rvan met the then-Prime Minister of Canada. Jean Chretien, in a meeting at his office on Parliament Hill. The Prime Minster commended the Ryan's Well project and made a \$100 donation right from his wallet to help support Ryan's dream!



#### 2001

Community leaders and volunteers helped form the Rvan's Well Foundation, an NGO aimed to help alleviate water problems around the world!

#### 2002

Rvan attended World Water Forums in 2003 and 2006, in Kyoto, Japan and Mexico City, as well as the World Summit on Sustainable Development in Johannesburg, South Africa in 2002. There, he shared his expertise with like-minded individuals about the importance of water all across the globe. Ryan was invited to attend yet another World Water Forum in Sweden this past August.



#### 2003

At age 12, Ryan was the youngest EVER recipient of the Order of Ontario!



#### 2006

Herb Shoveller wrote and published the awardwinning children's story "Ryan and Jimmy and the Well in Africa That Brought Them Together," which tells the story of Ryan's journey, and Jimmy, Ryan's Ugandan pen pal who became a part of the Hreliac family.





#### 2009

This year marked the very first School Challenge, which has continued every year since! Students around the world fundraise to support a Ryan's Well project, and receive updates in real-time, to see how their hard work is paying off!

#### 2009

Finn Case joined the incredible group of kids who have helped support us over the years, including Keana, who created and sold pottery jewelry, and Taylor, who, at age five, raised enough money through lemonade stands to have his own well constructed. We couldn't do what we do without all of our young supporters!



#### 2011

To celebrate the Foundation's 10 year anniversary, we unveiled a brand new logo, the same one we use today!

# BOUNTIFUL REWARDS FROM PROJECT WORK



The 2017-18 fiscal year saw Ryan's Well and our partners undertake the most work over the course of one year than at any other time in the Foundation's history. We saw the completion of 111 water projects in Burkina Faso, Uganda, Kenya, Ghana, and Haiti, and implemented Community Organization Committees and WASH (water, sanitation and hygiene) training with each project. We were only able to do this amount of work because of the incredible financial support we received throughout the course of the year. During our current fiscal year, we hope to surpass project work completed in 2017-2018, placing a strong emphasis on helping schools, maternity wards, health clinics, and hospitals.

Our yearly audited financial reports are posted on our website, and so you, as a valued donor or potential donor, are better able to see exactly how we allocate our funds. We pride ourselves on total transparency, and ensure that you can see the work we accomplish easily on our website. Or, if you are unable to find what you are looking for, that we pick up our phones, and can answer any questions you may have for us.

This is a special year for us as we celebrate 20 years of Ryan being on this path. We have stayed focused on WASH, Motivation, and Education since the very beginning. We have chosen to stick to our strengths, and not stray from our mission simply to attract funds. At the age of six, Ryan was on a mission - one that has increased in intensity as time has passed. Over 925,000 people now have access to potable water as a result of people around the world who have walked step by step alongside Ryan since 1998.



#### A DIVINE PARTNERSHIP



Our work would never be at the level of quality it is without our amazing partners. It's only by working together with indigenous partners, like Divine Waters, that we are able to help so many gain

access to safe, clean water. Ryan was able to spend months on the ground with Divine Waters at the beginning of 2015, planning projects and collaborating with local communities to improve the longevity and reach of each project site. In January of 2018, Ryan visited Divine Waters to look back on last year's work and prepare for our upcoming year. Sustainability doesn't happen by accident; it takes hard labour, diligence, and a strong commitment. Our work with Divine from this last year was some of the most exemplary work we have achieved, and we couldn't be happier to showcase all the amazing work our partnership has accomplished!

## DELIGHTFUL DONORS

Hear, in their own words, how and why long-term donors Hugh and Sherri Faloon chose the Ryan's Well Foundation.



It was about five years ago that we were invited to an event for Ryan's Well by Ron Little. It was not the first time we had heard about the foundation; Sherri and I remembered hearing the story of a young boy from Kemptville who, on his initiative, funded a well because he could not believe everyone didn't have access to clean water. Listening to the evening's program, and through our discussions with Jane, the Executive Director at the time, we knew we wanted to find a way to get involved.

We had been involved in well projects through another organization and were aware that there were risks, and that they must have the right people and process in

place to ensure success. The Ryan's Well Foundation had the teams, contractors and village council control procedures in place to reduce the overall risk of our investment and, most importantly, ensure these communities could benefit from access to clean water for many years to come.

We were very pleased to see that, through the construction of three wells, we were able to exceed our goal of providing clean water to 1,000 people. But we have to thank the Ryan's Well Foundation and their teams for making this a reality. They did all the hard work and will continue to monitor these projects. All we did was attend a charitable event five years

ago and write three cheques. I have often thanked Ron Little for inviting us to the event which turned out to provide us with the ongoing gift of allowing us to help more children than we ever thought possible. So thank you Ryan, Mark, and the whole team, for your help with these wells, and for the amazing work you do on a daily basis to make life so much better for so many deserving


