

School Challenge 2011/2012 Kenya - Ngong Sub-County Water Supply



Step 2 – Community meetings, discussion and planning to determine what residents want, how they envision their water access and the important role of the community in the project.



Step 4 – Construction of tanks will begin with residents being responsible for assisting with their tanks and for others in their community. Residents will also be expected to have a basic latrine constructed before tank construction begins.



Step 1 – The skilled team at MEDEC, lead by Sammy Oleku (in white jacket) work with 50 common interest groups in the region to support sustainable development of water, sanitation and many other programs.



Step 3 – Women of Ngong Sub-County will learn about materials needed and gain skills to construct household rainwater harvesting tanks.



Step 5 – Women of Ngong Sub-County and their families will have a rainwater harvesting tank that will fill up during the rains and be used through the dry season. Community members have gained knowledge and awareness of water, sanitation and hygiene along with access to water!
